## You may be her miracle match!

Amy has leukemia and needs a bone marrow transplant to survive. Since tissue type is inherited, the best chance of finding a genetically matched donor for Amy, as well as hundreds of other patients in similar circumstances lies with those of **Eastern-European Jewish ethnic ancestry**. Representatives from the Gift of Life Bone Marrow Foundation, North America's only Jewish donor Registry, will be present to register potential donors and answer your questions about this life-saving medical resource for the Jewish community.

- ✧ Donors will be entered into the Gift of Life Bone Marrow Registry for the benefit of patients worldwide in desperate need of life-saving matches.
- ✧ Eligible donors must be between the ages of 18-60 and in general good health.
  - ✧ Registration involves a simple swab of cells from inside the cheeks (No blood required at this stage).
- ✧ Gift of Life's mission is to increase the representation of the Jewish people in the registry.
- ✧ *Those previously tested do not need to be retested.*
