## could it be you?

For many Jewish children and adults suffering from leukemia and other blood-related diseases, the only hope for a cure is a bone marrow transplant. Tissue type is inherited and the donor pool is not representative of all ethnic groups. Gift of Life's mission is to increase the representation of the Jewish people in the Registry.

## Find out how you can save a life...

- Eligible donors must be between the ages of 18-60 and in general good health.
- Blood type doesn't matter.
- Registration involves a simple swab of cells from inside the cheek. (No blood required at this stage.)
- Pregnant women CAN be tested.
- Those previously tested do not need to be retested.
