## Be tested!

- Eligible donors must be between the ages of 18-60 and in general good health.
- Blood type doesn't matter.
- Registration involves a simple swab of cells from inside the cheek. (No blood required at this stage.)
- Pregnant women CAN be tested.
- Gift of Life's mission is to increase the representation of the Jewish people in the registry.
- Those previously tested do not need to be retested.

## You may be his miracle match!

Dennis has leukemia and is in need of a bone marrow transplant. Since tissue type is inherited, his best chance of finding a genetically matched bone marrow donor lies with those of **Eastern-European Jewish ethnic ancestry**. Donors will be entered into the Gift of Life Bone Marrow Registry for the benefit of patients worldwide in desperate need of life-saving matches.
