Since tissue type is inherited, Eve's best chance of finding a genetically matched donor lies with those of Jewish ancestry. However, there are many patients of all backgrounds in need of donors for transplants, so we encourage everyone to join the registry!

It's easy to join the Gift of Life Registry!

- Eligible donors must be between the ages of 18-60 and in general good health.
- Registration involves a simple swab of cells from the inside of the cheeks (No blood required at this stage).
- Those previously tested do not need to be retested.
- The legislators in several states have passed laws that make it mandatory for most insurance companies operating in these states to pay for the HLA testing.
