

Mission & Vision

Gift of Life Bone Marrow Foundation helps children and adults suffering from leukemia, lymphoma, other cancers, and genetic disorders find matching donors for blood stem cell and bone marrow transplants through the ongoing development and qualification of its international registry. The vision of Gift of Life is simple: A match. Anytime. Anywhere. For anyone.

Need

Every year, more than 10,000 patients in the United States are affected with life-threatening diseases, such as leukemia or lymphoma, and their best or only hope of a cure is from an *unrelated* bone marrow, blood stem cell or umbilical cord blood transplant. Approximately 75 percent of patients in need of a transplant do not have a matching donor in their family. They rely on Gift of Life and other registries to find a match. Since its founding in 1991, Gift of Life has facilitated more than 2,600 marrow and blood stem cell transplants for children and adults worldwide.

Our Beginning

When founder Jay Feinberg was diagnosed in 1991 with leukemia and told he would need a bone marrow transplant to survive, he had no idea that his personal journey would result in the establishment of a grass roots organization that would later save the lives of hundreds of patients in need. But that's precisely what happened. It was the last participant in the last donor drive who became Jay's donor match and saved his life. This hope transcends to each patient in need today.

Gift of Life Bone Marrow Foundation is a nonprofit organization with a 501(c)3 status in the United States, which relies on the generosity of donations to help offset the costs of the \$60 lab processing fee for each kit to increase the donor registry, and inevitably save more lives.
