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Bostonian blood cancer survivor meets stem cell donor at Gift of Life 5k

BOCA RATON, Fla.--(May 1, 2017)--A blood stem cell transplant recipient met his lifesaving donor at the third annual Gift of Life Marrow Registry Steps for Life 5K held on April 30, 2017 in Boston, Mass. Nearly 600 people attended and witnessed the emotional initial introduction of the pair and they hugged and shed tears of joy.

New York City resident, Cheryl Rosenberg, donated her blood stem cells in June 2015 to lifelong Bostonian 67-year-old Peter Levine. A retired co-owner of Ross Dry Cleaners, Levine was diagnosed with non-Hodgkin T-cell lymphoma in 2014, and no one in his family was a match so he turned to the Gift of Life marrow donor registry.

Rosenberg, 24, who joined the registry at Camp Moshava in Honesdale, Pa. almost seven years ago, said she was overjoyed at receiving the call that she was a match, and never questioned if she would go through with the donation process when Gift of Life reached out to her.

"It was my obligation and absolute desire to help this man as much as I possibly could," said Rosenberg. "I felt this overwhelming sense of excitement to learn that I could really have an impact on someone's life."

Levine, who recently moved to Frederick, Md., feels Rosenberg was brave, kind and giving. "Doing this for me is something I will forever be grateful for," he said. "Without Cheryl and Gift of Life, I might not be here today celebrating my second life."

Due to the donor program's privacy policy neither party could share their identities until a year after the procedure. On Sunday they were finally able to meet. After their introduction, the two led the start of the run/walk race, with McKesson Corporation and Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts serving as Platinum sponsors.

Almost 100 runners and walkers swabbed their cheeks to join the Gift of Life registry in order to help those facing life-threatening blood cancers.
